Three-time Carnegie Hall performer Haley Marie became the founder and director of Aurelia Productions in 2011, a company devoted to presenting classical music in new, authentic ways to audiences. Her captivating presentation of live classical music mixed with multimedia and storytelling has been praised throughout Canada and the United States. Miss Marie has performed as a soloist in Europe and North America and holds degrees from the Royal Conservatory of Music, McGill University and the prestigious School of Music at Yale University, where she studied on scholarship. Haley Marie has toured regularly as a soloist with Aurelia Productions for the past five years, making the company one of the most extensively-toured organizations of its type in North America.

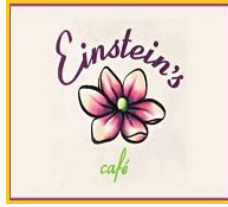
