as well as the presentation of medals and scholarships.

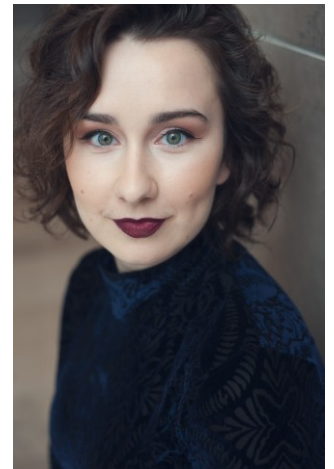
