Dr. Christopher Miranda

Canadian pianist Christopher Miranda's achievements began from an early age, including first prize in the Toronto Symphony Piano Competition, TD National Music Competition, The Mississauga Performing Arts Award, The Kesri Arts Award, The Canada Council Professional Music Grant, and the Felix Galimir Award for Excellence in Chamber Music.

After being a scholarship student of the Young Artist Performance Academy (now Eli Taylor) of the Glenn Gould Professional School at the Royal Conservatory of Music studying with Marina Geringas; he went on to earn his Bachelor and Master of Music Performance degrees with Mariela Orlov at the University of Toronto, an Artist Diploma under the tutelage of Claude Frank at Yale University, and the Doctor of Music in Performance and Literature degree from Indiana University under the mentorship of Menahem Pressler.

Christopher's performances as soloist and chamber musician have been heard on television and radio including on CBC, CJRT 91.1fm, CHCHtv, and Bravo! television. As teacher, he has been guest faculty at universities, music institutions and festivals across the continent, and is an annual competition adjudicator across Ontario. Dr. Miranda has a large private teaching studio online and at home in London, Ontario, and at the #1 People's choice and Consumer choice awarded Mississauga School of Music, and where his students are annual regional and provincial competition winners, recipients of multiple RCM gold medals, and full scholarships to university.
